THREE SCHOLARSHIPS OF SEK 200 000 EACH FOR RESEARCH INTO ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The postdoc scholarship holders must have completed their doctorates (or equivalent) within a field relevant to business and entrepreneurship. Applicants in the fields of entrepreneurship and innovation are particularly encouraged, as are applicants in the fields of entrepreneurship and intellectual capital and university-industry relationships.. This research will take place in 2010, with the Institute for Innovation and Entrepreneurship at the School of Business, Economics and Law as a base. The scholarship funding is estimated to be able to finance approximately eight months' full-time research. In addition, the scholarship holders will be expected to present their research in connection with various events at the School of Business, Economics and Law, and also to participate in various networks in respect of research into entrepreneurship both in Sweden and abroad.

These scholarships are intended in the first instance for younger researchers who have recently completed their doctorates (within three years), but "senior" researchers with doctorates granted more than three years ago and who have senior lecturer skills may be considered.

Applications must be submitted to the Faculty Administration Office at the School of Business, Economics and Law, Box 600, SE-405 30 Gothenburg, Sweden. The applications must include a brief outline of the planned research project in addition to the usual qualification documents (Personal letter, CV, Transcripts, 2 letters of recommendation).

Applications must be received by us by Monday, 12 October 2009 at the latest. Bromanska stiftelsen för forskning och företagande plans to make its decision on recipients in December 2009.

According to the Statutes of Bromanska stiftelsen för forskning och företagande, it is possible for holders of this scholarship to receive it on a maximum of three occasions.
